The type of personal information we collect

We currently collect and process the following information:

- Your full name and title
- Your postal address and other addresses as needed for delivery purposes
- Your email address and phone numbers(s)
- Where we understand you have found us e.g. Google advertisement or an exhibition
- Photo of your identification card (eg Blue Lights, required for discounting purpose)
- Notes from our telephone or chat conversations that provide information on your system setup and home situation with regards to numbers of people using the facilities
- Email correspondence, that provides technical information for the specification process
- Photographs of your pipework and fixtures and fittings as needed for warranty and guarantee purposes
- If you are a business contact, we may hold any of the above information plus your company name and business contact details



How we get the personal information and why we have it

Most of the personal information we process is provided to us directly by you for one of the following reasons:

- To request further information on our system and products
- To seek advise regarding which unit is suitable for your property
- To apply for a discount prior to purchase
- To register for a warranty or guarantee

This information is usually provided to us via

- A website form or chat function
- An email or phone call to us
- A competition entry
- You scanning us at an exhibition or providing us with your details on paper
- Scanning our information boards on permanent exhibition stands
- Referral of you by a friend or family member
- Your installer asking us to get in touch with you

We use the information that you have given us in order to

- Send you the information about our product and system that you have requested and will find useful to make a well-informed decision
- To send you updates about discounts, free tickets to exhibitions and similar opportunities
- To share useful data about money, energy and carbon saving including other products we believe you may find interesting
- To ask you to provide us with a review or recommend us to your friends and family
- To keep you updated with any changes to the product or company that may be relevant to you either as a prospective customer or as an existing customer to ensure your rights are protected.



We will never share this information with any person or organisation unless required to by law.

Under the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR), the lawful bases we rely on for processing this information are:

- (a) Your consent. You are able to remove your consent at any time. You can do this by contacting us on the details above by post, email or phone.
- (b) We have a contractual obligation

How we store your personal information

Your information is securely stored in our password protected database on a secure server.

We keep all elements of customer personal and system data for up to 30 years as this is required for warranty purposes

We will then dispose your information by permanently deleting your data from our database. Any personal information gathered on paper is shredded as soon as it has been transferred into our secure database.

At Halcyan Water, we are committed to protecting your privacy and ensuring that your personal information is handled in a safe and responsible manner.

As part of our efforts to provide an excellent user experience, we utilize Microsoft Clarity, a web analytics tool, to gain insights into how our website is used and to improve its performance.

1. What is Microsoft Clarity?

Microsoft Clarity is a user behaviour analytics tool that helps us understand how visitors interact with our website. It provides us with insights such as:

- Heatmaps: Visual representations of how users click, scroll, and interact with various elements on our site.
- Session Recordings: Replay of user sessions to analyse browsing patterns.
- Insights: Data on user behaviour to help us optimize the user experience.



2. What Information Does Microsoft Clarity Collect?

When you visit our website, Microsoft Clarity may collect the following types of information:
